

TPS for Afghans Application Overview



Who is Eligible?

- → TPS has been announced for Afghans already living in the US as of March 15, 2022 or before. TPS is valid for a period of 18 months.
- → Afghans arriving after March 15, 2022 are not eligible for TPS.
- → Afghans who have received humanitarian parole will be also be eligible to apply for TPS

Can I apply for Asylum & TPS?

- → Yes you have the right to apply for both TPS & Asylum
- → We advise you to see legal guidance if you plan to do so
- → There are some legal considerations that you need to learn about

When to Apply For TPS?

The deadline to apply for TPS for Afghans has not yet been announced.

→ Check on USCIS website for further instructions on when to apply:
<u>Temporary Protected Status | USCIS</u>

- *TPS is valid for a period of 18 months after publication in the Federal Register government bulletin
- → TPS will likely be extended indefinitely for those who apply during the appropriate window of time.
- → It is very important that you register timely once a deadline has been announced. There are exceptions for late filing as well, but it cannot be guaranteed so it is best to apply timely.

Work + Travel Permits under TPS

Under TPS, a person cannot be deported back to their country.

You can also apply for a work permit in a separate application form:

I-765, Application for Employment Authorization

You can also apply for travel (in different country than your own)

I-131, Application for Travel Document

These forms can all be filed at the same time as the TPS application.
